

MARIBYRNONG PARK TENNIS CLUB MEMBERSHIP RULES

The following membership conditions will ensure the enjoyment and comfort of the tennis club by all members.

General Behavior

1. We ask that members respect the Club's courts, facilities and equipment and play within the spirit and the etiquette of tennis at all times.
2. After playing, members must take away their used water bottles and other rubbish from the courts, they should pick up their tennis balls and ensure the gates are locked when leaving the courts.
3. No smoking is permitted within a ten (10) metre perimeter of the tennis courts, the clubrooms and public areas outside the courts.

Access to the courts

Social memberships players are free to use any of the courts except:

- a. Court 1 (to minimize its wear and tear during the year)
- b. During night competition held (Tues, Wed, Thurs and Friday)
- c. Junior and adult competition held (All day Thursday and All day Saturdays)
- d. When courts are used by MPTC's professional coach (Courts 5, 6 and 7 should be available during coaching times)
- e. During any scheduled Pennant and Tournaments competitions

The committee will do its best to notify all members by email if there are any changes to the above conditions

Current Membership fees and fobs

MPTC membership runs from **1 February to 31 January** each year.

1. The above Membership fees are payable within 30 days of invoice. If members are not financial after this time, their access to the courts may be removed and they may not be able to participate in competition tennis until they renew their membership.
2. A joining fee will only ever be charged once and will not be charged to a returning member.
3. Fobs will be issued to all **new** members on email request to secretary@mptc.org.au after membership has been paid. The membership coordinator will then contact the member to organise fob collection.
4. Members who will no longer require their membership, (for example moving to another part of Melbourne or interstate/overseas, or long term injury or illness) may be entitled to a refund on the balance of their membership depending on the circumstances upon written notification to secretary@mptc.org.au and at the committee's discretion.
5. Fobs are not transferrable and must not be loaned to non-members. Members breaching this condition may have their membership cancelled with no refund given.
6. Please report loss of the Fob or any issues using it to secretary@mptc.org.au . A replacement Fob will cost \$10. A short video on how to use your fob is on our website. www.mptc.org.au

Using the clubrooms

1. Members who use the clubrooms and kitchen must tidy up afterwards including:
 - a. wiping down tables to remove crumbs/spills, washing and putting away any crockery or cutlery
 - b. vacuuming the floor (the vacuum is in the broom cupboard to the right of the kitchen).
 - c. putting rubbish in bins
 - d. when leaving, turn off the interior lights and if used, heaters, fans, kitchen appliances and the TV , closing any open windows and ensure the club room doors are locked

3. The club rooms and courts are not available to hire for 18th, 21st birthdays or any other adult parties. The club may be available for hire for children' parties at the Committee's discretion.
